Each student will be assigned a mentor professor for consultation during his/her

Eligibility	 ✓ Be currently enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at an NCHU partner institution. ✓ Have successfully completed at least one year of study at home institution. ✓ Be nominated by the Office of International Affairs or equivalent office of the home institution according to exchange agreements. 			
Benefits	 Tuition waiver (The fees of mandatory insurance and accommodation are not included. Students need to pay both fees by themselves.) Results will be announced by the end of June and mid-December for Fall and Spring semester, respectively. Step 4: Official admission package will be sent to program coordinator of partner institutions. Step 5: Admitted students need to confirm admission and provide arrival information
