We are looking forward for the participation of your two student leaders to the ASEAN Young Leaders for Innovation 2016.

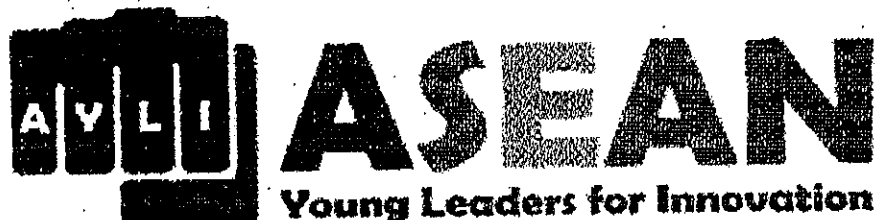

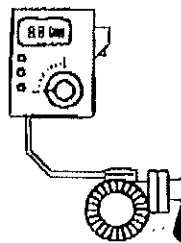

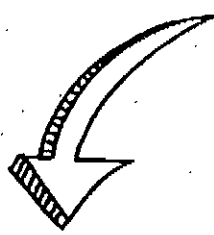


#### **ASEAN YOUNG LEADERS FOR INNOVATION 2016 (AYLI2016)**

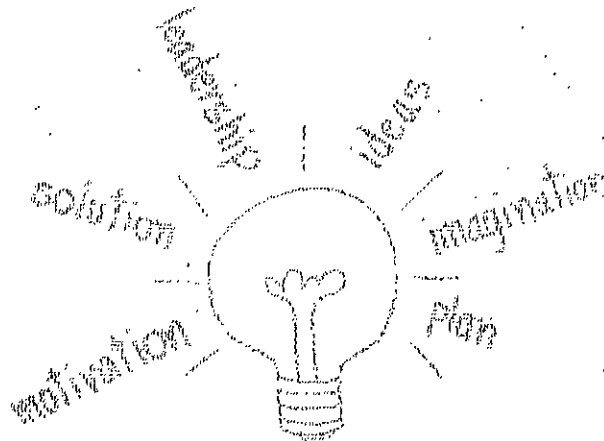
