

SEAMEO RIHED encourages all interested applicants to apply early and will notify applicants and confirm participation within one (1) week of taking receipt of completed applications. Payments made up to the application deadline of 20 October 2017 will benefit from the early bird rate of €2499. Payments made after 20 October 2017 and no later than 20 November 2017 will be in the amount of the regular rate of €2799.

Payment and Confirmation of Participation Deadline: 20 November 2017

The fee covers 6 nights' accommodation in hotels, an academic programme that includes the SEAMEO RIHED-DAAD Seminar and visits to 5 leading German higher education institutions as well as the Max Planck Institute for Radio Astronomy. In addition, the programme includes visits to the Heidelberg Christmas Market and the Mercedes-Benz Museum in Stuttgart, domestic transportation in Germany by coach, English-speaking guides, meals, printed materials and a Certificate of Participation. Coverage of visa fees and insurance for Germany is also available for participants and confirmed participants can also expect to receive official invitation letters from DAAD to support their visa application process in their home country.




