MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY SRIVIJAYA, THAILAND AND

UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA SARAWAK, MALAYSIA

In order to promote academic cooperation between Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya (RUTS), Thailand, whose address is at 1 Rachadamneonnok Rd. Boyang subdistrict, Mueang District, Songkhla Province, 90000, Thailand, and Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (UNIMAS), Malaysia, whose address is at 94300, Kota Samarahan, Sarawak and (hereinafter referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties"), this Memorandum of Understanding has been agreed to encourage contact and cooperation of mutual interests between two Parties. Both Parties have expertise in language, communication and education.

- 1. The Parties will jointly develop academic cooperation to attain the goals of the following forms of activities:
 - a) Exchanging lecturers and students;
 - b) Conducting some scientific and academic activities;
 - c) Conducting research, seminars, training programme and workshop;
 - d) Publishing international journals; and
 - e) any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the universities.
- 2. The Memorandum of Understanding will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five (5) years. This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties by issuance to the other Party of a written notice

- signifying its intention to renew or further the period not less than three (3) months prior to the Expiry Date.
- 3. This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by one of the Parties, upon prior notice to the other in writing at least six (6) months before the termination date.
- 4. This Memorandum of Understanding will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to other. Each Party will bear its own cost and expenses in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 5. This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.
- 6. Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.
- 7. Any difference or dispute between the universities concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties through diplomatic channels, without reference to any third party or international tribunal.
- 8. Either Party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this Memorandum of Understanding. Any such revision, variation or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this Memorandum of Understanding. Such revision, variation or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties. Any revision, variation or amendment shall not prejudice the implementation of any project, activity or co-operation arising from or based on this MoU before or up to the date of such revision, variation or amendment.
- 9. Any communication under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be in writing in the English language and delivered by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail

address or facsimile number of UNIMAS or the RUTS, as the case may be, shown below or to such other address or electronic mail address or facsimile number as either university may have notified the other Party and shall, unless otherwise provided herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such address or electronic mail address or facsimile number which is duly acknowledged:
