

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY SRIVIJAYA AND

## SOUTHERN TAIWAN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

In order to promote cooperation between Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya, Thailand, and Southern Taiwan University of Science and Technology (STUST), Taiwan, the following the following memorandum of understanding has been agreed: to the extent feasible, both universities will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty members, departments and schools. The two universities will endeavor to cooperate on education and research areas of mutual interest. Within the fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of cooperation will pursued:

- 1. Exchange of faculty, researchers and other research and administrative staff;
- 2. Exchange of students;
- 3. Conduct of collaborative research projects;
- 4. Conduct of lectures and symposia;
- 5. Exchange of academic information and materials; and,
- 6. Promotion of other academic cooperation as mutually agreed.

Joint activities are the most appropriate way of ultilizing the results achieved, as well as special visits could be arranged. Exchanges and other forms of cooperation will be developed mutually in each specific instance. Agreements entered by Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya may be subject to review and approval by the University Council.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements of funds will have to be negotiate and will depend on the availability of funds.

Representatives of both universities are signatories in the expectation of promoting mutual friendship and cooperation. The agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years. It shall be extended automatically for an additional period of five years at each expiration date unless either party gives six months advance notice in writing to terminate the agreement.
