Academic Cooperation Agreement

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote cooperation between CHONGQING UNIVERSITY OF POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS (Hereinafter called "CQUPT") and RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY SRIVIJAYA (Hereinafter called "RUTS"), considering their common interest in promoting mutual cooperation in the areas of education and research, the two institutions agree to enter into this formal agreement for the purpose of developing academic cooperation programs.

Article 1: Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic cooperation programs on the basis of equality and to promote relations and mutual understanding between both universities.

Article 2: Scope of the Cooperation

Subject to the terms of this agreement, both parties undertake to promote and develop academic cooperation as follows:

- 1. Development of dual bachelor's degree programs in the fields of engineering.
- 2. Development of combined bachelor's degree programs in the fields of engineering.
- 3.Development of customized education programs and doctoral degree programs for engineering professionals.
- 4. Other educational and academic exchanges and collaborative programs.

Article 3: Agreement of Implementation

A detailed description of the scope of any cooperative activities by the parties shall be defined in one or more Agreement of Implementation. Each Agreement of Implementation will include such items as:

- 1. Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed upon activity.
- 2. Schedules for specific activities.
- 3. Budgets and sources of financing for each activity.
- 4. Intellectual property ownership of the results of collaborative activities and related terms.
- 5. Insurance and general legal provisions relating to collaborative activities.
- 6. Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity in accordance with all applicable laws.

Article 4: Settlement of Differences

The parties will endeavor to settle any differing viewpoints and interpretations of this agreement in an amicable manner by mutual consultation or negotiation.

Article 5: Amendments, Duration and Termination

- 1. Amendments and supplements to this agreement require the written consent of authorized officers of both parties.
- 2. This agreement will take effect after it is signed by both parties and shall be valid for the period of 5 years and will be automatically extended after mutual consultation.
- 3. This agreement may be terminated by either party by written notice at least six (6) months in advance. Unless otherwise agreed by parties, such notice of termination will not interfere with cooperative programs currently underway and such programs will be allowed to continue until their conclusion.
