Therefore, they agree to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), which would permit scholarly pursuits that benefit both parties as well as promote their friendship in the long term.



Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation and collaboration will include but not limited to:

- Faculty exchanges and visits,
- Students exchanges and visits,
- Joint education or research programmes in the fields of maritime study when mutually agreeable and feasible, and
- Periodic exchange of information of mutual interest with respect to the matters such as curriculum, training, facilities, and instructional methods.

This MoU may be implemented with annexes concerning specific forms of cooperation between the two universities. For instance, annexes may be proposed and signed on a later date. Once they have been signed by both parties; however, the annexes are considered as an integral part of this MoU.

This MoU will be effective upon the date of signature by the authorised representatives from the two universities; it shall remain in force initially for a period of five years. In addition, it may be either amended or extended by mutual written consent of the universities.


