The College of Aquaculture and Fisheries, Can Tho University, Viet Nam and The Faculty of Science and Fisheries Technology, Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya, Thailand agree to enter into this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to implement the following collaborative activities *in fields of aquaculture and fisheries*:

**1. Exchange of teaching and research personnel**

Lecturers and researchers with different strong specialization from the two parties are invited to give courses or seminars to undergraduate and graduate students and staffs, especially to the international educational programs of the parties at appropriate times

**2. Exchange of students**

Under graduate and graduate students from each party are regularly invited to conduct exchange programs such as degree programs, credit exchanges, short training courses, seminars, study tours, thesis research, cultural performance, between the two parties.

**3. Collaboration in research projects**

The two parties agree to cooperate to develop, apply and conduct international-link research project regarding different interested or concerned issues in aquaculture and fisheries. Teaching staffs and researchers from each party are invited from time to time to conduct joint researches in other party.

**4. International training, workshop, study-tour programs**

The two parties agree to establish the international or joint short training – workshop, study-tour programs for local and international trainees (farmers, technicians, company managers or local officers). The specific courses will be identified yearly. Experts, professors from one party will be invited to offer the training-workshop organized at another party. The two parties will support each other in organizing and guiding the study tours for trainees from each party.

**5. Publication of research result**

The two parties agree to publish joint research results at international journals and books on aquaculture and fisheries.

**6. Organizing of symposium and other academic activities**

The two parties agree to organize bilateral joint symposium, and work together with other ASIAN partners to organize the alternative and annual International Fisheries Symposium (IFS) that was initiated since 2011.

**7. General agreements**

The two parties agree to work their best for specific joint projects or programs as mentioned above. Detailed programs and projects including activities and budgets will be determined accordingly. This MOA may be modified through discussion of the two parties. This remains in effect from the date of signature for an initial period of five years. Thereafter it will be automatically renewed each year if there is no notice of termination from each party.
